

Huntington Hills “Andy Rominiecki” Scholarship Application Information 2026

The Huntington Hills “Andy Rominiecki” Scholarship was established by the Huntington Hills Civic Association (HHCA) and is funded by the dues provided for the preservation and enhancement of the quality of life for residents of our neighborhood. The scholarship was renamed in honor of former Huntington Hills resident and HHCA president Andy Rominiecki for his many contributions and dedication to making HH a better place to live. The scholarship consists of a minimum of a single \$1000 tuition grant to be awarded to a graduating high school senior that is a resident of the Huntington Hills Subdivision in Violet Township, Pickerington, Ohio. The purpose of this scholarship is to provide assistance to a deserving student in advancing his/her education. The scholarship may be applied to any type of schooling whether college, technical, business, vocational, or other acceptable post high school advanced training.

Completed applications should be returned to HHCA Scholarship Committee % Julie Wyatt, 6531 Riverton Circle, Pickerington, Ohio 43147 by May 1, 2026 at 5 PM. Applications must be typed and will not be accepted or considered after the deadline.

Eligibility

1. Any high school student that is graduating from an accredited high school or equivalent in the year they submit the application and has been a resident of the Huntington Hills Subdivision for a minimum of one full year is eligible to apply for this scholarship.

2. At the time of applying the family of a student that applies for the scholarship must be a member in good standing of Huntington Hills.

3. The student has completed a minimum of 16 (sixteen) hours of approved community service for the Huntington Hills Civic Association (HHCA).--see community service suggestion link

4. The completed application for the scholarship must be received by May 1, 2026 at 5 p.m. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted. A completed application includes the following items:

: The application information was typed and completed in full.

- One letter of recommendation from a school instructor.
- One letter of recommendation from an adult outside the school community. This adult may not be a parent or relative.
- Official Academic Transcript (with school's seal embossed on it).
- Documentation of service hours by a HHCA Trustee or chairperson responsible for that project.

5. The student must be accepted to at least one institution of higher learning at the time of application. Applicants are responsible for printing off and having the chairperson sign off on community service hours. This documentation must be submitted with the application.

6. The following individuals are not eligible for the scholarship: Members of the immediate family of the current Scholarship Selection Committee.

All information will be kept strictly confidential. The Scholarship Selection Committee reserves the right to interview the candidates for clarification of for printing materials on the application or other information

one from someone outside the field of education but not a parent or relative

These recommendations are to be included with the scholarship application. For those writing Letters of Recommendation: Please use the following questions as a guide in writing your recommendation but include any pertinent information you feel will be a value to the selection committee. All information will be treated in strictest confidence.

Please limit your response to 200 words or less.

1. In what ways does the applicant show his/her maturity?
2. To what extent does the student utilize his/her personal capacity and the opportunities for learning that might be afforded?
3. How does the person demonstrate integrity, individuality, and respect?
4. In your opinion, why is this person deserving of a scholarship?
