# Getting ready for Spring means getting ready for outdoor maintenance.

# Outdoor maintenance can be overwhelming. Where should you start and when do you need a professional?

We have put together a basic spring maintenance checklist from our friends at the <u>National Association of the Remodeling Industry</u>.

#### Spring Maintenance Checklist:

Visually Inspect Roof: From the ground (or using a pair of binoculars), visually inspect the roof and look for missing shingles, rust, rot, or other damage.

Faucets: Inspect hose faucets for damage caused by winter freezes by turning on the water and placing a finger over the opening. If the water flow stops, the pipe may be damaged and should be looked at by a professional.

Woodwork & Decks: Look for warping, loose nails, and replace rotted/loose boards.

Clean out the Gutters: With spring, comes rain and you will want your gutters functioning properly. Damaged or debris filled gutters can cause foundation and basement damage. Although not fun, maintaining your gutters will save you future headaches.

Damaged Concrete: Inspect your concrete garage and the concrete around your home. Salt and the winter elements can cause pitting and the need for fillers or replacement (or if the damage is in the garage, repair coupled with epoxy coating is a nice option).

When do you need a handyman vs. contractor/remodeler?

A handyman is best suited to take care of general household repairs, i.e., many of the items on this list. A contractor/remodeler focuses on larger projects that often times change the scope of your home (like an addition, new kitchen, or other renovation).
